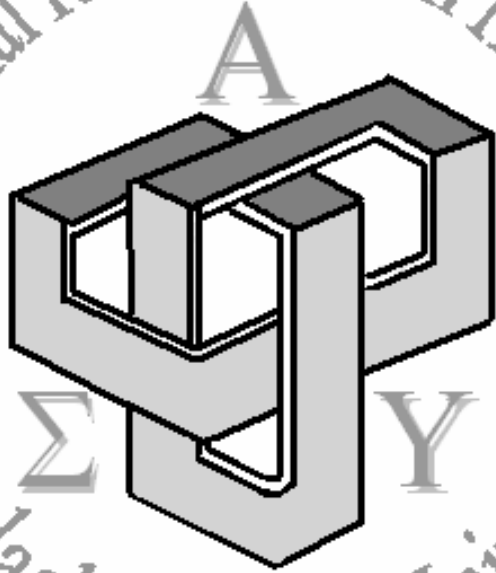

What is NRHH?

NRHH was established in 1965 as the sister organization of NACURH, Inc. (National Association of College and University Residence Halls). Its purpose is to recognize those students who have made outstanding contributions to the residence halls and residence hall associations on their campuses. Prior to NRHH, students involved in RHA's would spend a lot of time and effort trying to get people involved and excited about programs and events on campus and were often overlooked without even a thank you! Thus, NRHH was born!

What do we do?

NRHH's primary function is to recognize those leaders throughout the residence halls that go above and beyond each month by awarding "Of the Month" awards or OTMs. We also collaborate with RHA in most of their endeavors as we are brother / sister organizations. NRHH is also active in the NCARH, SAACURH, and NACURH, Inc. organizations along with RHA.

What is an OTM?

Of the Month's are awards recognizing OUTSTANDING service. Anyone can be nominated by anyone on campus! After submitting your OTM, the members of NRHH read and vote on the campus winner. All campus winners get sent on to possibly win at the State, Regional, and National levels. Just think, the person you nominate could be the Student of the Month for the entire nation! There are 13 categories of OTMs that you can write. They are as follows:

- RA
- Advisor
- Bulletin Board
- Community
- Executive Board Member
- NCC
- NRHH Chapter
- Spotlight
- Student
- Educational Program
- Social Program
- Diversity Program
- Community Service Program

OTM Criteria

The general body members of NRHH will be looking at your nominations to see if you answer the questions in each category below. To increase the possibility of your nomination not only winning on the Campus level, but the State, Regional, and National Level as well, make sure you write them to include the answers! Don't forget to be VERY MONTH SPECIFIC in your description!

ADVISOR OF THE MONTH

- ✓ Is the nomination month specific?
- ✓ Did the individual recognize the students they worked with in the month of nomination?
- ✓ Did the individual impact the students they work with during the month of nomination?
- ✓ What outstanding accomplishments did the nominee do that went above and beyond any other nominee?

BULLETIN BOARD OF THE MONTH

- ✓ Was the bulletin board created in the month of nomination?
- ✓ Was the bulletin board fun, educational, or both?
- ✓ What did the bulletin board look like (be descriptive!)
- ✓ How did this bulletin board impact residents?

COMMUNITY OF THE MONTH

- ✓ Is the nomination month specific?
- ✓ Who is included in this community?
- ✓ What did the community specifically do to deserve nomination?
- ✓ How did this community contribute to the overall community in the building?

NCC OF THE MONTH (National Communications Coordinator)

- ✓ How did the NCC in position go above and beyond their duties during the month of nomination?
- ✓ Did the nominee use the resources available to them through NACURH or any campus resources?
- ✓ What outstanding contributions were made by the individual during the month of nomination?

EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBER OF THE MONTH

- ✓ Is the nomination month specific?
- ✓ Did the individual from the central residence hall governing body (i.e. RSA, CRSA, NRHH)?
- ✓ Has the nominee used the services and resources of NACURH and campus resources?
- ✓ What outstanding contributions were made by the individual during the month of nomination?

NRHH CHAPTER OF THE MONTH

- ✓ Did the chapter recognize or contribute to student leadership on your campus during the month of nomination?
- ✓ Did the chapter impact the students they worked with during the month of nomination?
- ✓ What activities set this month apart for the chapter from any other month?

RESIDENT ASSISTANT OF THE MONTH (RA)

- ✓ How well does the nominee work with residents and what impact has he / she had during the month of nomination?
- ✓ Has the nominee fulfilled and gone above their job responsibility during the month of nomination?
- ✓ Are there any specific projects in support of hall government or committees that they have participated in?
- ✓ What outstanding contributions has the individual made for the hall they work in during the month of nomination?

SPOTLIGHT OF THE MONTH

- ✓ Does the nominee fit into only this category (i.e. this nominee does not really need to be nominated for any other category)?
- ✓ What contributions did the individual / group make to the residence halls during the month of nomination?

STUDENT OF THE MONTH

- ✓ What organizations and activities was the individual involved in during the month of nomination?
- ✓ What interaction did the nominee have with their residence hall association or individual hall during the month of nomination?
- ✓ Does the student work well and motivate others?
- ✓ What outstanding contributions were made by the individual during the month of nomination?

PROGRAM OF THE MONTH (4 categories)

- ✓ Which category does the program fall under? (Educational, Diversity, Community Service, or Social)?
- ✓ What makes the program unique from what is usually done?
- ✓ How can the program be adapted to other campuses?
- ✓ Did the program have lasting effects on residents?
- ✓ Did the program meet all the goals that were set?
- ✓ What was the quality or evaluation of the program?

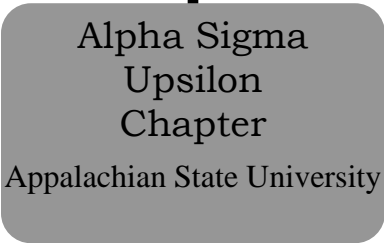

As a resident of the Language & Culture Community, this student was required to coordinate at least one activity / event during the year for her fellow residents / students. This particular student organized a program to fulfill that requirement as well as provide an opportunity for community bonding with the students in the community and on the hall.

This program was designed to provide an opportunity for members of a Residential Learning Community to come together as a group, share their talents, socialize with each other and faculty from the Community, and build ties to the larger community (i.e. the residence hall) where the Community is housed. Two resident student members of the community took the lead in organizing and advertising the program including creating posters, recruiting an emcee, recruiting artists from the Community and building to showcase art work, recruiting students to perform, obtaining audio/visual equipment, obtaining local sponsors, inviting faculty to participate, and coordinating refreshments.

On the evening of the event, the students decorated the lobby on the Community hall to provide the "atmosphere" appropriate to the "cafe" setting including special lighting and the assembling of a "house band" for the evening. As participants arrived, they enjoyed artwork displays from approximately seven students, original poetry readings, solo and group vocal performances, and monologues from famous writers and poets. All totaled, approximately 15 student performed during the course of the evening.

Approximately 125 students from throughout the Community and residence hall packed into the lounge to hear their fellow students perform. The atmosphere was enhanced by the presence of faculty associated with the Community and the support of several residence life staff from throughout the building and area. In addition, students were able to enjoy coffee, hot chocolate and other "coffeehouse" beverages as well as pastries donated by a local bakery. Students laughed, sang, and shared together for over two hours during this "open mic" event.

In the end, the event succeeded in meeting the goals that the students had established by bringing together students from throughout the building and giving them a unique shared experience. The success of this event lies in the ability of this student to coordinate and organize the event and bring her fellow students out in a unique and fun activity.
