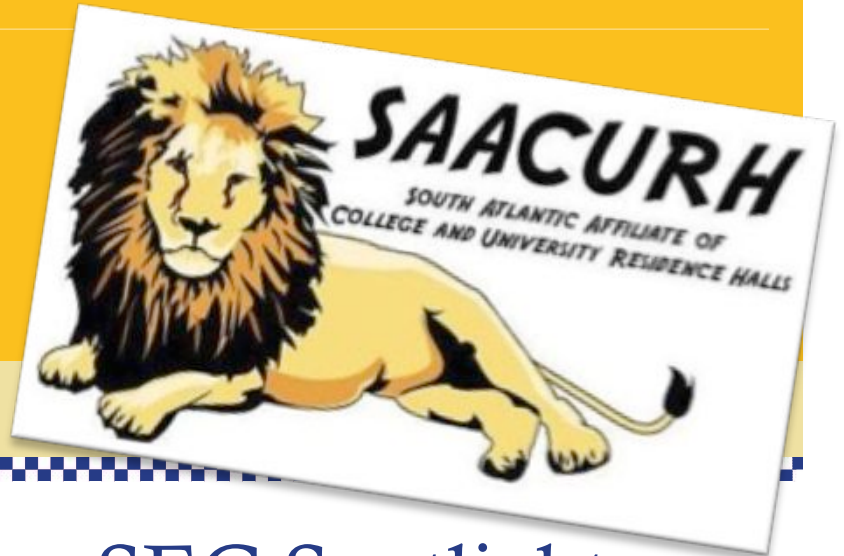

SAACURH Executive Committee...

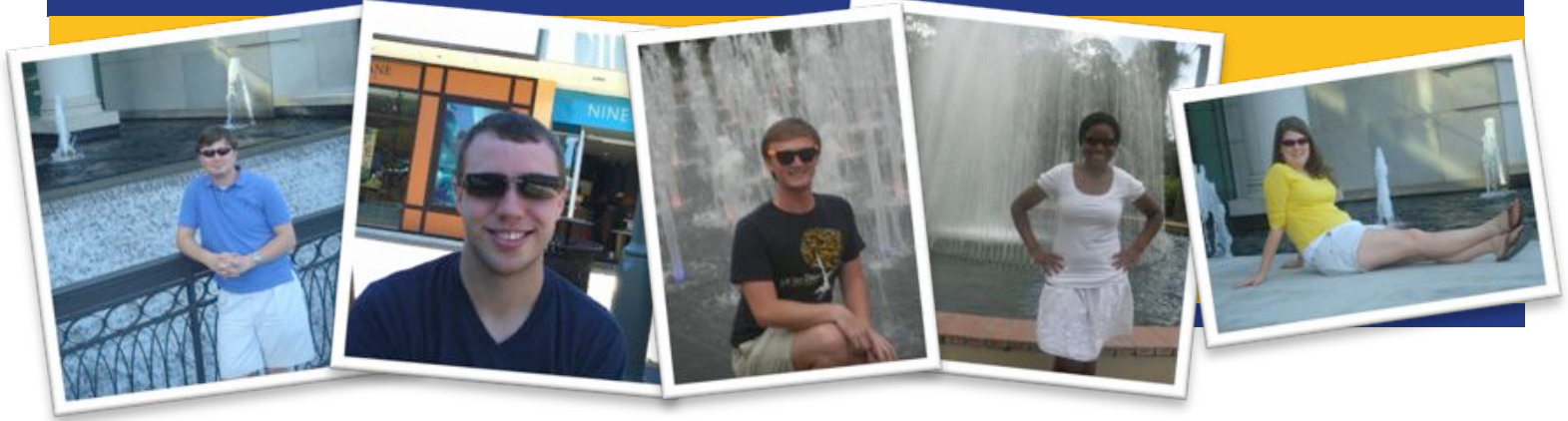
not to be confused with the Southeastern Conference :P

There are lots of things to get excited about for the national conference this year.

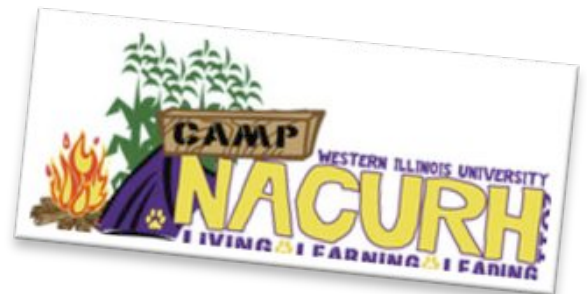
Whether you are a first-timer or a seasoned veteran, there will be something for everyone. And believe that SAACURH will be fierce at all times!
