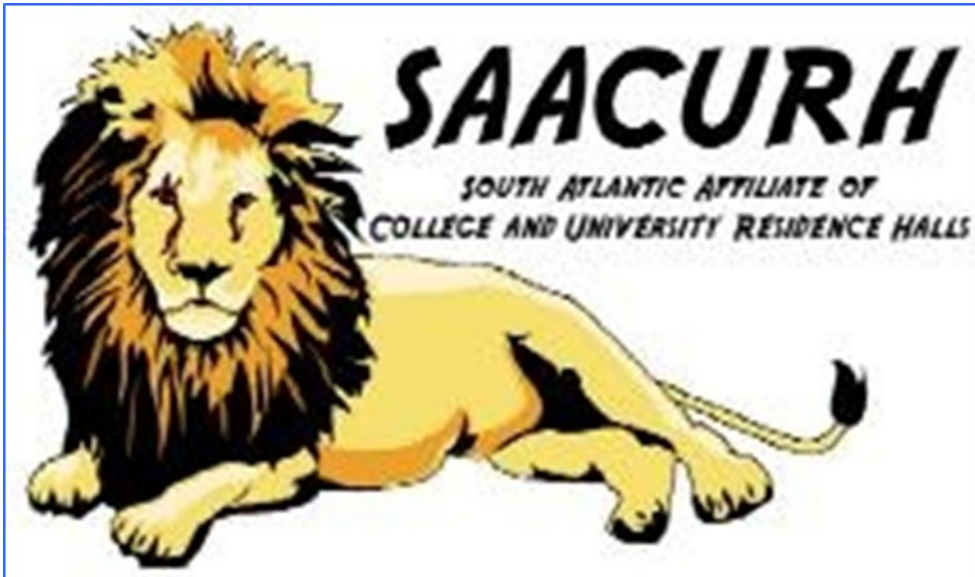

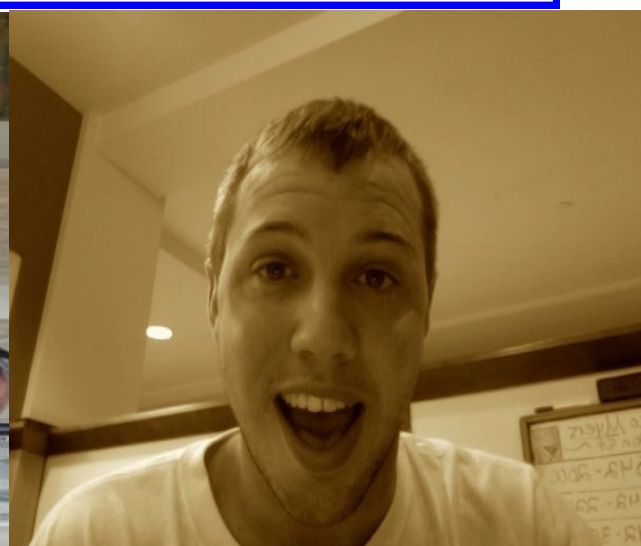


SEC Highlight SAACURH AD-BA Ryan Hill

Greetings from the conference staff



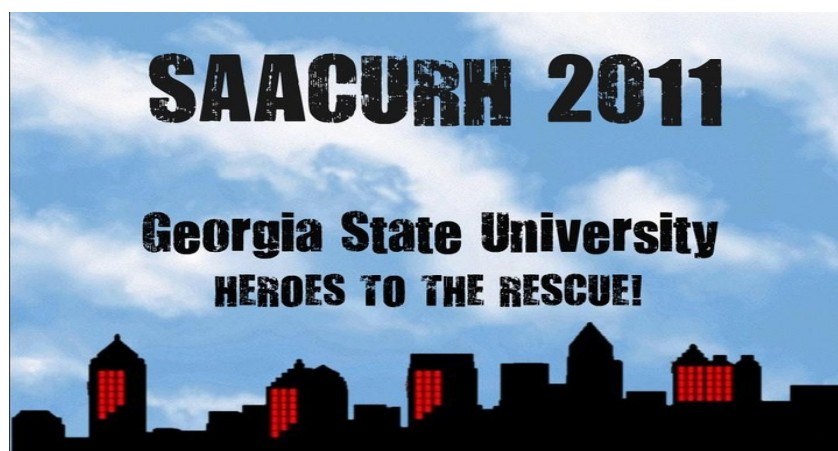
Hey SAACURH,

What is it?	How to Phrase it...	In English	2nd	Amendable	Debate	Vote to Pass
Main Motion	"I move that ..."	"We should do this ..."	YES	YES	YES	Majority
Amendment	"I move to amend the motion by (inserting) (striking) (adding)..."	"I have an idea to make this motion better..."	YES	YES	YES	Majority
Lay on the table	"I move to lay on the table the motion that..."	"Let's discuss this later and put it on the table."	YES	NO	NO	Majority
Take from the table.	"I move to take from the table the motion that..."	"Let's discuss the motion we put on the table."	YES	NO	NO	Majority
Move the previous question.	"I move the previous question."	Stops debate and leads to a vote by a vote.	YES	NO	NO	2/3
Request for information.	"Request for information."	"I have a question about the motion."	NO	NO	NO	Chair Decision
Point of Order	"Point of order."	"I think you are out of order."	NO	NO	NO	Chair Decision
Parliamentary Inquiry	"Parliamentary Inquiry."	"I have a question about Parliamentary Procedure."	NO	NO	NO	Chair Decision
Point of personal privilege.	"Point of personal privilege"	Special Request. Ex. "Could you speak a little louder?"	NO	NO	NO	Chair Decision
Suspend the Rules	"I move to suspend the rule that..."	"I want do something not allowed by the rules."	YES	NO	NO	2/3
Limit or Extend time for Debate	"I move limit (or extend) debate to..."	"I want to limit amount of time to debate."	YES	YES	NO	2/3
Refer to a committee	"I move to refer this issue to a committee."	"This needs attention outside of the counsel."	YES	YES	YES	Majority
Orders of the Day	"I call for orders of the day"	"Where are we?" "Lets get back on track"	NO	NO	NO	Chair Decision
Adjourn	"I move to adjourn the meeting."	"I want to end the meeting."	YES	NO	NO	Majority

Things to remember

- * Don't be afraid to ask questions. Everyone has to start somewhere.
- * Remain professional and do not attack other NCCs or NRHH reps.
- * Read all legislation and Bids before hand to make boardroom run smoother.
- * Passing notes is a great way to keep in touch with people across the room but please remember to be polite and not pass notes during presentations.
- * Have fun. Boardroom is a great place to meet new people and learn new things.
- * Make sure you fill out the bid criteria sheets online before the conference
- * NCCs will vote on SALT and Regional Advisor-Elect
- * NRHH reps will vote on POY
