WHAT IS NACURH U?

NACURH University or 'NACURH U' is a special set of programs designed to train and encourage the next leaders of NACURH and the individual RHAs and NRHH chapters across the nation. These programs will take place during the first morning of programming at NACURH 2010.

WHO CAN PRESENT AT NACURH U?

Anyone may submit a proposal for NACURH U, including NCCs, NRHH Representatives, RHA and NRHH Presidents as well as other leaders, RBD members, and NBD members. All NACURH U programs are selected from the submitted proposals by the NACURH U Commission.

These programs are meant to provide tools and resources for new NCCs, NRHH Representatives, RHA and NRHH presidents, and other leaders of NACURH and the regions. Other conference attendees are also welcome to attend. Examples of presentation topics include bid writing, Robert's Rules of Order, how to be an NCC or NRHH Representative, constitution writing, facing challenging issues, etc.

WHY PRESENT AT NACURH U?

Part of being a leader is sharing the knowledge you have learned with others. Share your skills with others to improve RHAs and NRHH chapters' schools across the country. This is also a great time to network with others around the nation in similar leadership roles as you.
