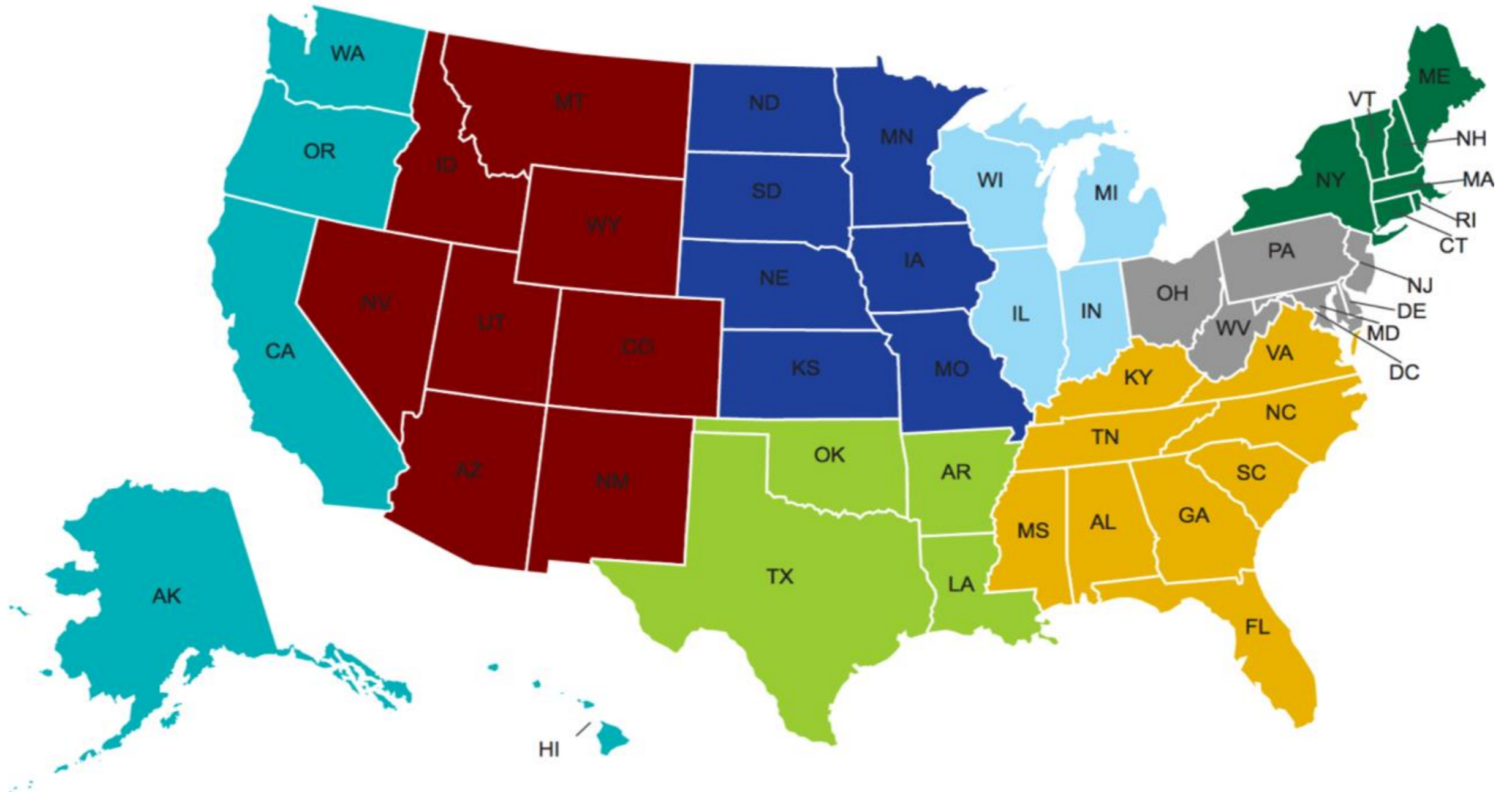


NACURH Affiliation Guide

What is NACURH?

NACURH stands for the National Association of College and University Residence Halls. The organization was formed in 1954 when student groups from four institutions came together in an effort to create something that would help the development of students in residence life across the country. Throughout the year, institutions affiliated with NACURH come together to exchange ideas, build relationships, and create a culture of growth and inclusivity. This culminates each year in an annual conference in which every one of our 400+ universities is invited to join us in celebrating our efforts and building to even better things.

 - Attend regional and NACURH annual conferences
 - Vote on regional and NACURH level legislation
 - Utilize the Resource File Index for ideas on enhancing residential life on your campus and reap the benefits of all NACURH resources
 - Submit and win awards to recognize the work you do
 - Access the benefits of all NACURH corporate sponsorships
 - Access all NACURH newsletters
 - Write and receive OTMs (Of the Months)



The Steps to Join:

- **The Resource File Index (RFI)**
 - Can be done a program from your campus RHA, a bid submitted at the past year's regional conferences, and positional bids from the past year
 - Minimum of 5 pages, submitted directly to the NACURH Corporate Office (NCO)
- **Census Questions**
 - Questions to be answered in direct correlation to your RHA & NRHH Chapters
 - Only answer NRHH Chapter questions if you have an NRHH.
- **NRHH Constitution**
 - Will need to be approved by the AD-NRHH before it goes to the NACURH Corporate Office (NCO).
- **NRHH Members List**
 - List of all current members in your NRHH Chapter
- **Payment**
 - \$110 USD to be fully affiliated with voting right
 - \$35 USD to be a NACURH Associate
 - First time affiliation only. (Schools that have not affiliated in 3 or more years)
